Title IA- Disadvantaged Students

- FY26 Preliminary Allocation: \$617, 985.77

 - Title I Coordinator 0%
 - Literature/Mathematics Specialists and Supplies
 - Ralph Atwood Elementary School 23.2%
 - Belgrade Central School 19.9%

 - Williams Elementary School 32.5%
 - Family Engagement 2%

Carryover funds will be used to expand services not covered by the amount of the allocation.
